TWO TRAINER ANGLES TO BOOST YOUR BETTING BANK IN FESTIVAL MONTH

There's no hiding from the fact that this month is all about one thing and one thing only - the Cheltenham Festival!

We shouldn't forget, however, that there's still plenty of other meetings going on (weather permitting!) out with the four days at Prestbury Park and the two trainers highlighted here have shown solid stats throughout recent March's, almost exclusively AWAY from Cheltenham.

As always, these angles won't make you rich but in recent years they have ticked along sweetly, picking off some consistent profits and adding a neat little boost to the betting bank.

Enjoy...

Trainer 1: HARRY FRY

Overall March record (since 2010)...

45/187 | 24% S/R | +£53.38 BFLSP - W&P 81/187 | 43% S/R

A decent overall winning percentage for Fry in March, with a solid number of winners in the bank and some decent profits to go along with it as well. Things can, as always, be tightened up further with a little digging...

Harry Fry March Angle...

H Fry – March – National Hunt

C4/C5/C6 Non-Handicaps

5yo – 9yo

1-2 starts last 90 days

Days Since Last Run (DSLRL) 11-90

Results...

21/38 | 55% S/R | +£73.03 BFLSP - W&P 25/38 | 66% S/R

89% above expectation | 143% ROI (Betfair)

A couple of very minor losing years on this angle but in general Fry has this sub-section of his string in fine fettle during March.

Trainer 2: JENNIE CANDLISH

Overall March record (since 2010)...

41/199 | 21% S/R | +£104.46 BFLSP - W&P 73/199 | 37% S/R

March is by far the most fruitful month for team Candlish, with her next best strike-rate months being August (14.5%) and April (12.5%), Spring clearly being the time her yard bounces into a rich vein of form. The overall stats by themselves are strong enough but as always we can tighten things up further...

6yo – 11yo

DSLR 45 or less

SP 20/1 or less

29/88 | 33% S/R | +£98.69 BFLSP - W&P 42/88 | 48% S/R

80% above expectation | 112% ROI (Betfair)

Another consistent little bank builder, with only one very minor losing year since 2010 (-3 point loss in 2014, where all 3 qualifiers placed); a neat ‘under-the-radar’ type angle to keep firmly in mind.
