Introduction

Handicap Sleepers, you know the sort. Those types that are slipping down the ratings, past their highest winning mark/official rating. The sort that people are ignoring because they think they are out of form. Yeah them, that's a Handicap Sleeper and I keep track of a vast quantity of them, waiting for them to meet certain criteria before putting the cash down and hopefully collecting at a tasty price.

But what makes a Handicap Sleeper?

Essentially I'm looking for a horse who's current OR (Official Rating) is LOWER than their highest ever win OR, ideally they will also be below or at least near their last winning OR. Added to their OR mark I also need to be able to establish strong trends and preferences from their winning AND losing past form, or in other words I like to be able to attribute <u>Prime Conditions</u> to the horse in question, conditions I'll be sitting and waiting for them to appear under so that myself (and <u>full NTF Members</u>) can get the money down and look to pull in profit.

For those of you that have followed me for some time this won't be a completely new concept to you. I've produced many similar free guides like this over the past ten or so years, highlighted similar types of horses to keep an eye on and to profit from. I've also ramped this side of my analysis up a few notches during the 2021 NTF Summer Members Service, examples of such you can see <u>HERE</u>.

Handicap Sleepers are horses I considered to be 'well-handicapped' AND also horses where I could pinpoint strong trend patterns to their winning performances. I regularly highlight these types for full NTF Members, along with the conditions they <u>are proven to act best under</u>, continually scanning the entries and my mountain of horse notes, looking for the perfect time to get the money down. This FREE Handicap Sleepers guide works along the same lines and same principles.

The runners in this guide...

All horses on the list are here because they are perceived to be well handicapped by myself on old form (and official figures, of course) and I have been able to identify strong race conditions that they excel under. They are taken from a much larger set of personal notes that I constantly update, refine and tweak, making sure I'm as ahead of the game as I possibly can be. The horses in this particular guide are also ones I've noted as 'coming into form' or 'runner better than the bare form suggests' and also have previous strong form in the latter part of the season/year.

This isn't a get rich quick scheme...

Again if you have been following me for any length of time you know that's not what I'm about. I put in the hard work and study to get the results. My 'Handicap Sleepers' method is a method I personally use to source large priced winners. Not all the time of course, not all of them will be as 'under the radar' each time they hit the track as I would like them to be, but they offer plenty enough value plenty enough times to make it a worthwhile method to add to my overall portfolio. You do sometimes have to endure losing streaks with the method but this has to be expected. You are often dealing with runners at the lower end of the market (larger odds) and you honestly can't expect them to win time after time, day in day out.

How do you profit from Handicap Sleepers?

Luckily for you I've done most of the hard work! I've sourced the horses and laid out their **Prime Conditions** for you. All you need to do is keep an eye out for them running.

With this method you need take the highlights with the close calls, the big winners with the not even on the radar runs, hopefully the close calls return some each-way nuggets allowing you a profit from your efforts, but you have to accept that you may have to wait a few runs to profit from a handicap sleeper, again this isn't a get rich quick scheme.

What to do now...

Read the guide, familiarise yourself with the runners and their traits. If you use an alerts tool then enter them in there with my notes attached.

As is always the case with an NTF guide it is entirely up to yourself how you wish to utilise the information and how you add it to your own punting armoury. I would, however, suggest having some sort of each-way cover for the larger priced runners, whether that is with the traditional bookies or indeed on the exchanges. The strike-rates for this sort of method will be low-ish but the returns more than make up for it.

*Note. Sometimes these runners will win out with ideal conditions, without our money down. It happens; we deal with it and move on.

**Note. It's not always a case of waiting for ALL conditions to be ticked for a horse, you can sometimes be waiting forever for that to happen. If for example 4 of the 5 conditions are ticked it's a case of making a judgement call based on price and how important the missing angle is in conjunction with that days race.

BRINGITONBORIS (K DALGLEISH)

Current OR 71 | Highest winning OR 73 | Last winning OR 73

4yo – 21 career starts, 3 wins

Overall Form line - 5/834471423117-64548742

Prime Conditions

OR 73 or below 1m Handicaps DSLR 25 or less September - November

When all of the above conditions are met he has a form line of... 113241 (3/6, 2p- all 3 career wins)

Notes: He has run well over 7f trips and is worth considering there if all other boxes are ticked and he's getting a decent pace to aim at

SAAHEQ (Mrs M Perrett)

Current OR 76 | Highest winning OR 87 | Last winning OR 80

7yo – 51 career starts, 8 wins

Overall Form line - 0443/11357/51421074024451/7570240300763-441231258190474

Prime conditions (Turf races only)

Straight 5f OR 85 or less Fields of 11 or more Good or Good to Soft ground

When all of the above conditions are met he has a form line of... 18111 (4/5 - All 4 Turf wins)

Notes: Can be a keen runner so likes the cover and pace of a large field to help him settle. Has also won 4 times on the All-Weather

SPANISH MANE (Miss J Feilden)

Current OR 57 | Highest winning OR 58 | Last winning OR 58

6yo - 32 career starts, 6 wins

Overall Form line - 866/86513517/3F09015/5345135110-6945

Prime conditions - (Turf races only)

OR 58 or less Good or quicker ground 7f-1m Handicaps June-September

When all of the above conditions are met she has a form line of... 113155109131 (6/12, 2p – all 6 career wins)

Notes: 4 of her 6 wins have come in the August-September period (overall form of 1155511) and she does tend to peak at the back end of summer/start of autumn

SINGE ANGLAIS (N TINKLER)

Current OR 62 | Highest winning OR 66 | Last winning OR 60

4yo - 20 career starts, 4 wins

Overall Form line - 9511815/65097-99351243

Prime conditions

OR 66 or less C5 level or less Straight Tracks July-September

When all of the above conditions are met he has a form line of... 4211115 (4/7, 1p - all 4 career wins)

Notes: Likes a decent pace to aim at as he likes to come with a late run

PIVOINE (A Balding)

Current OR 93 | Highest winning OR 104 | Last winning OR 91

7yo – 35 career starts, 7 wins

Overall Form line - 31/99411/0714610/6640159246/34078-741692

Prime conditions

OR 104 or less Class 2 level or less June or later Days Since Last Run 45 or less 1m-1m3f trips (running round a bend)

When all of the above conditions are met he has a form line of... 2618711641111 (7/13, 1p - all 7 career wins)

Notes: Has very strong form at Class 3 level or less...2110114913 (5/10, 2p - 5 of 7 career wins)

Where to get more Handicap Sleepers...

Naturally, if you have the time, you can source your own. It's a time consuming process, no doubt about that, but it IS a worthwhile task and it WILL point you towards plenty of winners that the wider betting public are ignoring.
