

TWO-YEAR-OLD DEBUTANTS (TURF): THREE SIRES TO NOTE

KINGMAN

Overall record since start of 2018

37/177 | 21% S/R | +£129.96 BFLSP – W&P 80/177 | 45% S/R – 10% above exp

The KINGMAN kids have been a profitable bunch to follow as 2yo's on debut, striking at a solid rate and pulling in some tasty profits at the same time.

A bit of digging, however, tightens things up even more...

Males V Females

Kingman 2yo Males on debut

26/105 | 25% S/R | +£138.06 BFLSP – W&P 56/105 | 53% S/R – 19% above exp

Kingman 2yo Females on debut

11/72 | 15% S/R | -£8.10 BFLSP – W&P 24/72 | 33% S/R – 8% below exp

The Kingman Males look to be more forward for their debuts (as a group) than their female counterparts...

Track Direction

Kingman Turf debutants | Right-Handed or Straight tracks

34/139 | 24% S/R | +£153.56 BFLSP – W&P 69/139 | 50% S/R – 26% above exp

Kingman Turf debutants | Left-Handed tracks

3/38 | 8% S/R | -£23.60 BFLSP – W&P 11/38 | 29% S/R – 55% below exp

A strange one this, perhaps, but the stats tell us that they have much stronger stats on debut away from Left-Handed tracks...

Other Angles to note

JOHN & THADY GOSDEN have some very strong stats with their Kingman 2yo turf debutants...

12/26 | 46% S/R | +£62.87 BFLSP – W&P 19/26 | 73% S/R – 83% above exp

CHARLIE APPLEBY has done well with the limited number of Kingman offspring he has had in his yard...

6/11 | 55% S/R | +£8.26 BFLSP – W&P 9/11 | 82% S/R – 56% above exp

Conclusion

The Kingman kids, like their father, look sharp and ready to hit the ground running for their debut runs and the market doesn't seem to have fully caught up with them just yet.

The following looks an interesting 'angle' to note...

**Kingman 2yo debutants (Turf) | Males | Flat or Slightly Undulating
RH/Straight tracks**

20/63 | 32% S/R | +£149.82 BFLSP – W&P 41/63 | 65% S/R – 43% above exp

...like most angles though I'd try and remain flexible where possible...

DUBAWI

Overall record since start of 2018

37/198 | 19% S/R | -£33.78 BFLSP – W&P 91/198 | 46% S/R – 21% below exp

Only KODIAC has sired more 2yo debutant winners on turf than DUBAWI since the start of 2018, the market is, however, fully aware of this and backing them all blind would have left you with a fairly large hole in your betting bank.

So we need to dig a bit for some profits...

The Market

Dubawi Turf debutants | SP 4/1 or less

32/110 | 29% S/R | -£6.22 BFLSP – W&P 62/110 | 56% S/R – 13% below exp

Dubawi Turf debutants | SP >4/1

5/88 | 6% S/R | -£27.56 BFLSP – W&P 29/88 | 33% S/R – 50% below exp

Money talks when it comes to DUBAWI 2yo debutants (as it often does with 2yo's) and although those near the head of the market still run at a loss (if backing them all) it certainly tightens things up plenty...

Males V Females

Dubawi 2yo Males on debut

28/125 | 22% S/R | +£5.14 BFLSP – W&P 65/125 | 52% S/R – 11% below exp

Dubawi 2yo Females on debut

9/73 | 12% S/R | -£38.91 BFLSP – W&P 26/73 | 36% S/R – 40% below exp

The Dubawi Males outperform the Females on debut and there were even some minor profits to be found backing them blind...

Field Size

Dubawi 2yo's on debut | fields size 12 or less

34/148 | 23% S/R | +£1.60 BFLSP – W&P 74/148 | 50% S/R – 9% below exp

Dubawi 2yo's on debut | fields size 13 or more

3/50 | 6% S/R | -£35.38 BFLSP – W&P 17/50 | 34% S/R – 68% below exp

No major surprises here – less runners to beat = more chance of winning – but the strike-rate splits are hefty and look worth noting...

Other Angles to note

Those debuting over 1m+ trips show strong stats...

13/62 | 22% S/R | +£15.35 BFLSP – W&P 25/60 | 42% S/R – 4% above exp

CHARLIE APPLEBY has good figures when debuting a Dubawi 2yo on NEWMARKET's JULY course...

10/24 | 42% S/R | +£10.93 BFLSP – W&P 16/24 | 67% S/R – 37% above exp

Irish bred (IRE) Dubawi 2yo's show decent debut figures...

20/69 | 29% S/R | +£0.75 BFLSP – W&P 41/69 | 59% S/R – 13% above exp

Conclusion

The Dubawi 2yo kids are generally ready to fire first time up although finding a profitable way into them takes a bit of digging. The following 'angle' is possibly worth keeping in mind...

Dubawi 2yo debutants (Turf) | IRE bred | Fields of 12 or less | SP 4/1 or less

17/33 | 52% S/R | +£17.18 BFLSP – W&P 24/33 | 73% S/R – 43% above exp

...although as always I'd remain loose enough with that and use it as a guide rather than gospel...

NIGHT OF THUNDER

Overall record since start of 2018

20/102 | 20% S/R | +£51.32 BFLSP – W&P 35/102 | 34% S/R – 36% above exp

Night Of Thunder himself is by Dubawi out of a Galileo mare and spent the majority of his racing career at the top level, winning the 2000 Guineas and the Lockinge and placing in numerous other Group 1's. As a sire he's now passing on his race class and strong breeding lines to his kids, with plenty of them also being ready to roll first time out (as he himself was)...

The following areas are where his 2yo debutants have thrived...

Distance

Night Of Thunder | Turf debutants | Trips of less than 7f

16/61 | 26% S/R | +£52.40 BFLSP – W&P 25/61 | 41% S/R – 74% above exp

Night Of Thunder | Turf debutants | Trips of 7f+

4/41 | 10% S/R | -£1.08 BFLSP – W&P 10/41 | 24% S/R – 27% below exp

The Night Of Thunder kids show plenty of speed on debut (like their dad, who won over 6f on debut) and to date the sprint trips have been a strong starting point for them...

Track Direction

Night Of Thunder Turf debutants | Straight tracks

19/84 | 23% S/R | +£65.53 BFLSP – W&P 31/84 | 37% S/R – 52% above exp

Night Of Thunder Turf debutants | Left-Handed/Right-Handed tracks

1/18 | 5.5% S/R | -£14.21 BFLSP – W&P 4/18 | 22% S/R – 55% below exp

This would tie in with the distance stats but it's still something worth monitoring...

Month

Night Of Thunder Turf debutants | April-July

15/61 | 25% S/R | +£52.45 BFLSP – W&P 24/61 | 39% S/R – 51% above exp

Night Of Thunder Turf debutants | August-November

5/41 | 12% S/R | -£1.13 BFLSP – W&P 11/41 | 27% S/R – 5% above exp

Perhaps not a huge amount in this one but those hitting the track in the first half of the flat season have produced better stats than those making their debut in the second half of the season...

Conclusion

Some decent stats to chew over for the Night Of Thunder kids and although I wouldn't necessarily be looking for a hard and fast angle for them, the following did catch the eye...

Night Of Thunder 2yo debutants (Turf) | Straight tracks over <7f | Class 4 races

11/27 | 41% S/R | +£64.55 BFLSP – W&P 15/27 | 56% S/R – 142% above exp
